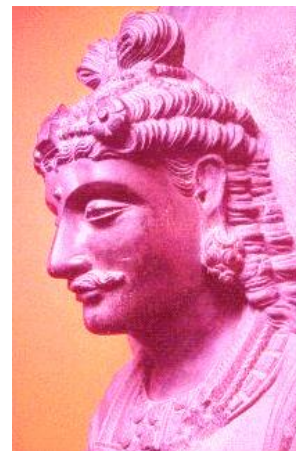


LORD MAITREYA
